## TOPIC OF THE MONTH: WATERPROOFING

Arguably one of the most important components of your bathroom remodel is the **shower waterproofing system**. If you are considering a bathroom remodel, I recommend discussing the waterproofing system with your contractor. The three most common systems currently in use are:

- Foam boards. Common brands include Schluter's Kerdi board, Wedi board, Laticrete's Hydro Ban board, and many other newer brands.
- 2. Sheet membranes. Including Schluter's Kerdi membrane, Laticrete's Hydro Ban sheet membrane, Ardex, and others.
- Liquid-applied membranes. Including Redgard, Mapei's AquaDefense, Laticrete's Hydro Ban liquid membrane, and others.

The most vulnerable areas in any shower waterproofing installation are where the walls meet the shower floor or tub lip, where the floor meets the drain, and at all seams. No matter which system you or your contractor chooses to go with, make sure that these areas are being installed per manufacturer's specifications.

At MF Custom Works, **our waterproofing system of choice** is Schluter's Kerdi system. In my humble opinion, Schluter is the gold standard for waterproofing systems, and they stand behind their products with a lifetime warranty. We use a combination of their foam board and sheet membranes for a 100% waterproof installation.
